## About West-MEC

West-MEC's Aviation Maintenance Technology Program is certified by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as a 14CFR Part 147 Airframe and Powerplant Technician School.

Our FAA Airframe & Powerplant (A & P) Mechanic Prep Class is for individuals who meet the aviation experience requirement and have received their sign off from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The sign-off is on FAA Form 8610-2. This form authorizes you to be administered the written exams and the oral and practical Airframe & Powerplant test. Without this form no testing is authorized.

## Registration & Enrollment

Registrations are done during normal business hours. We provide testing by appointment only. You are considered enrolled upon payment of your deposit.

## What to bring with you

Two original FAA Authorization Forms, 8610-2 for any mechanics licensing. You will get these from your local FAA office. Upon providing proof of your aviation mechanical experience (30 months A & P, 18 months A or P) the inspector will sign giving you approval to test. You must present these original documents to West-MEC in order to be eligible for enrollment.

Listed above are prices for our average local O&P testing fees. The O&P price can vary from \$500-\$750 depending on which DME you schedule with.

### 3 Computer Test (\$150 each.)

Test fees are priced for our average local testing fees. Fee will be paid to testing site.

## Required Payments

There will be three separate payments required:  
Tuition - paid to West-MEC.  
Computer test - paid to test site.  
O & P test fees - paid to DME.

A \$250 deposit is required to reserve a seat in class. The deposit will be applied to the cost of your tuition on your first day. The \$250 deposit is non-refundable if you fail to show for your scheduled class. However this deposit may be applied to a later class date if proper notice of cancellation or rescheduling is afforded to the West-MEC Exam scheduler.

## Payment Methods

West-MEC accepts Visa, MC, American Express, Discover and debit cards. We also accept sponsored program payments such as title 31 Disabled VA. Most Vets are eligible for Reimbursement of testing fees through the VA by filing form 22-0803.

Minimum class enrollment thresholds must be met in order for the class to be offered.
