## Distribution Logistics

Project SEARCH is an international program model empowering young adults with significant disabilities to make a successful transition from school to adult life. Participants will be taught relevant, marketable skills while immersed in the working world.

Project SEARCH – Distribution Logistics, 1080 hours, at Core-Mark ADC provides young people with significant disabilities comprehensive training in distribution logistics coupled with quality unpaid internships for hands-on training and career exploration.

West-MEC staff deliver Distribution Logistics and general employability curricula during the morning classroom; instruction is reinforced as interns acquire employability and competitive work skills through rotation assignments. The program takes place entirely within Core-Mark's distribution facility. Interns receive support, as needed, in their rotations. Counseling services are also available. The goal for each intern upon completion of the program is competitive employment in the community.
