Job Title: Facilities and Construction Tech

Supervisor: Facilities and Construction Maintenance Manager

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide back-up responsibilities for the Facilities and Construction Maintenance Manager as it relates to daily tasks and assignments.
- Ability to perform general maintenance tasks to include but not limited to landscaping, carpentry, electrical, HVAC, plumbing, and custodial duties.
- Be able to troubleshoot and assess all repairs and maintenance.
- Oversee the general maintenance of buildings and campus equipment.
- Assist with TI project and campus improvement project management as needed.
- Perform minor repairs on various items, example: electrical outlets/switches, ballasts, lights, doors, hinges, electric appliances and water heaters.
- Follow procurement procedures.
- Become knowledgeable in specialty systems for energy management and security system.
- Assist with District fleet maintenance management (including maintenance equipment, aerial equipment and forklift).
- Coordinate equipment repair, maintenance and inventory of District's equipment.
- Assist and coordinate with vendors to ensure maintenance plans and repairs completed in a timely manner.
- Assist and manage security and access management systems for employees and vendors.
- Assist with service contract management, scheduling and coordination.
- Travel between campuses when repairs are needed.
- Assist with Audio Visual system operation and repair.
- Participant in Culture of Safety Committee, Benefits Committee and Strategic Plan Vision Element II.
- Assist with the District's Emergency Response Plan implementation.
